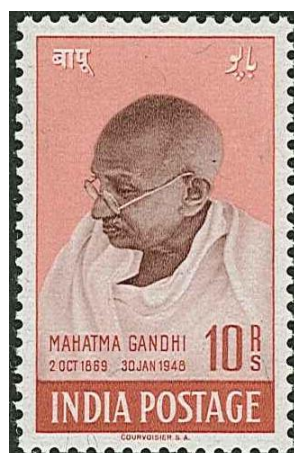

Includes many stamps cat. a few pounds each – noted China, Germany (inc. 3rd Reich), UK with Penny Black (top-left corner missing), 1867 5/- u. This relates to all lots in this auction which have the "[1a]" symbol in their description, signifying that they will not be taken to the auction venue. It will be arranged so that these lots can be viewed at our shop premises on auction day, and that purchases can be collected that same evening.

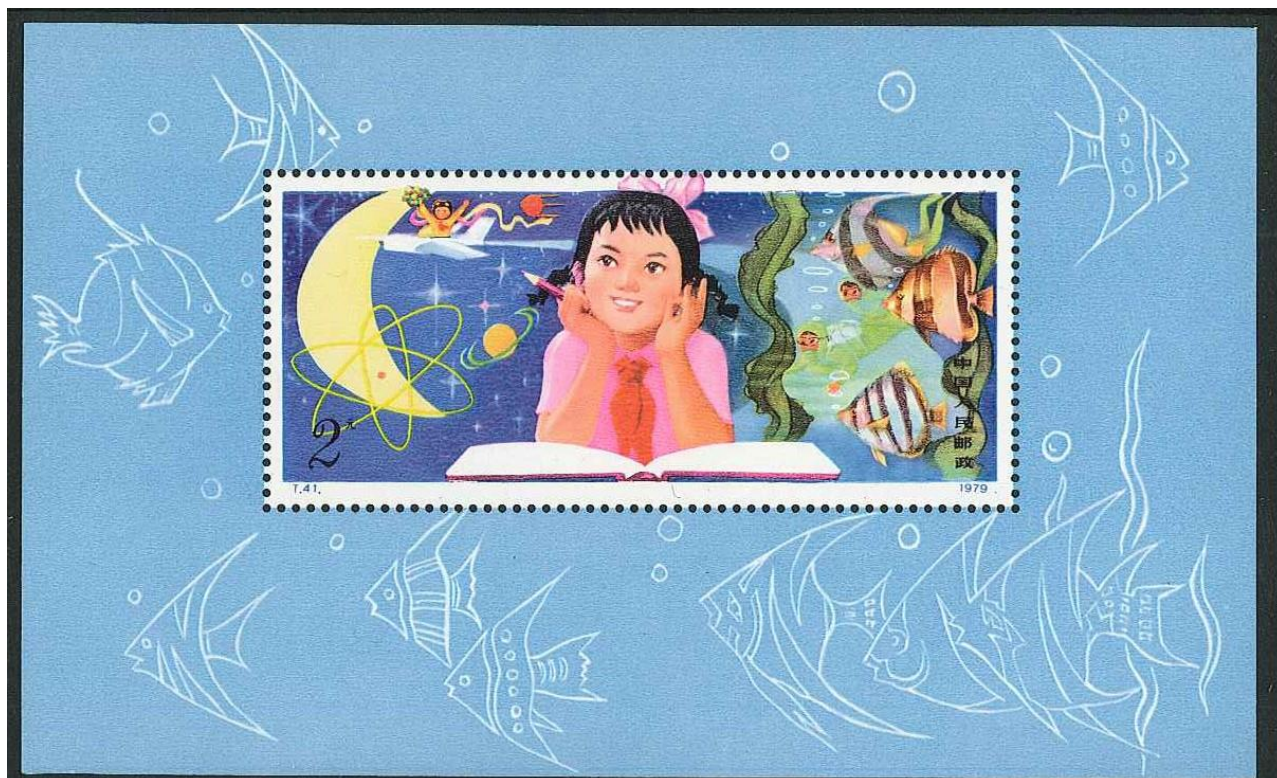
